

Guidelines For Submission

Authors must sign a letter, and can retain a copy for files and return the original. A signature on this agreement does not restrict the author from incidental reprinting of the Work, using it in a course or conference proceeding, or including it in a book containing your works, provided a proper credit line is included (Copyright 2004 The Corrected View, The Orthokeratology Academy Of America Reprinted with permission). Submitted materials should be sent as a rich text document or as a basic text document. Additional materials, (such as pictures, charts, bio's etc..) should be sent independently of the main article either as a part of the original E-mail or as a separate E-mail. Please label all files appropriately to designate them from other author's material. This can be done by renaming files with author's last name followed by the purpose of the designated material (herzbergpic, lipsonchart1, or reimpix05, etc..)

AUTHOR BIO AND PICTURE:

Please include with article a short bio of the author and a picture of the author. Bio's should read as a list of accomplishments or highlights, please limit the bio to only relevant information pertaining to author accomplishments, including contact information is also acceptable.

PICTURES:

Please send all pictures in either JPEG or TIFF formats only. Label all pictures accordingly as indicated in the previous paragraph. Keep submitted pictures to a limit of five or less, and please recognize that without specific instructions the OAA Journal staff has the right to use which ever submitted pictures they feel have priority according to layout.

SPECIFIC INSTRUCTIONS:

If the author has specific instructions that detail the priority of additional materials (such as pictures, charts, or bio) then the author should detail those instructions within the main body of the submission e-mail.

SUBMISSION POLICY:

The OAA journal staff has the right to deny submission based on relevance of submitted material. Journal staff may also have the right to hold particular articles for future publication.
